Colliers Engineering & Design, Inc. (DBA Maser Consulting) is pleased to submit this proposal to provide professional services to assist the Sewerage Authority with the identification and documentation of the practical and economic feasibility to utilize the capped, former New Jersey Natural Gas plant site for the purpose of supporting a financially viable solar photovoltaic (PV) project.

This proposal is divided into four sections as follows:

Section I – Scope of Services
Section II – Business Terms and Conditions
Section III – Technical Staff Hourly Rate Schedule and Reimbursable Expenses
Section IV – Client Contract Authorization

The order in which the following scope of services are presented generally follows the sequence in which the project will be accomplished; however, depending on the project, the various authorized services contained in this proposal may be performed in a sequence as deemed appropriate by Colliers Engineering & Design to meet project schedules.

Section I - Scope of Services

Based on our conversations and information noted above, we propose to complete the following:

Phase 1.0 Site Evaluation and Economic Analysis

Conduct inspections of the former NJNG plant property to evaluate site logistics, opportunities
and limitations. During the site inspection, we will discuss the site limitations with NJNG. It is our
understanding that the site is a contaminated and capped site. Our office will need to be provided
with the capping plan, as constructed, as well as the NJDEP or LSRP approval of said plan. It is

required that NJNG provide any associated conditions of the capping approval as they pertain to the proposed solar field. The capping design will also impact the solar field design to ensure that the proposed solar installation does not compromise the cap.

- 2. Evaluate and document the availability and condition of the utility interconnection infrastructure, as applicable.
- 3. Perform an analysis of the site and adjacent facilities' electric utility demand and historical consumption data.
- 4. Prepare a preliminary equipment layout to accommodate safety clearances, maintenance access and to minimize shading impacts.
- 5. Determine the estimated annual electricity production in kilowatt hours (kWh).
- 6. Develop an overall project capital cost estimate and a total project developer value model to identify and document the real-time market costs for and value of the potential project.
- 7. Develop a preliminary project economic summary that includes estimated total project cost, preliminary calculations of potential energy cost savings, and the estimated value of government and applicable financial incentives. An economic analysis will be provided. The analysis will consider multiple financing options to provide the City with the information necessary to determine the most economically advantageous method to implement the proposed PV project.
- 8. Calculate environmental benefits including annual greenhouse gas emissions reduction equivalencies.
- 9. Provide information on project development implementation options.

Phase 2.0 Research Funding Availability

Our team will research potential funding opportunities related to development of solar fields. Potential grant and low-interest financing opportunities are anticipated to be available through the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP), New Jersey Economic Development Authority (NJEDA) and the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Our office will conduct outreach to granting agency contacts to verify the project's eligibility for funding/financing and establish the requirements for making an application and implementing the project. Preparation of grant and/or financing applications is not included in this scope and can be provided separately.

LONG BRANCH SEWERAGE AUTHORITY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 16, 2021 TO NOVEMBER 14, 2021

We have treated an average daily flow of 3.13 MGD, the effluent quality being of a good degree with an average suspended solid discharge of 5.4 ppm and an average B.O.D. discharge of 10.3 ppm. We have met all limits of our discharge permit.

As previously reported, the Authority's Coronavirus (COVID-19) Plan and Increased Staffing Plan have been implemented and are currently on-going. Please note that plan adjustments/changes may be needed to address new situations as they arise.

The Division of Contract Compliance and Equal Employment Opportunity requires that a Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O) be appointed annually and submit contract compliance documentation to the Division. It is requested that I be appointed as the Public Agency Compliance Officer to collect the required documents.

The Holidays are fast approaching, and the staff here would like to celebrate and request a small lunchtime Holiday Party. Authority Commissioners and professionals are welcome to attend. It is requested that the 2021 Holiday Party and catering for same be approved. It should be noted that the Holiday Party may be cancelled if necessary due to COVID-19.

We have calculated daily and projected flows for the Capacity Assurance Program. Our average twelvementh flow is 3.895 MGD, with an additional 0.54769 MGD in approved and conceptual projects for a total of 4.443 MGD. This gives the Authority an additional available capacity of 957,312 gallons per day or 3,191 units based on 300 gallons per day per unit at full capacity, or 2,291 units based on 300 gallons per day per unit at 95% capacity.

The Authority's Collection System Crew for the month has investigated seventeen (17) stoppages, of which five (5) were the responsibility of the LBSA and twelve (12) were the private owners' responsibility.

Engineer's Status Report November 2021 Meeting Colliers Engineering & Design Project No. LBS-001

Dear Mr. Roguski,

The following is a report on the status of projects for which Colliers Engineering & Design is responsible:

1. WWTP Hot Water System Improvements (LBS-272)

The project was originally bid on February 11, 2020, and there were no bidders. A site meeting was held on July 6, 2021. Colliers Engineering & Design has revised the plans per the meeting and the project will be held for construction until a later date. A PDF of the plans will be provided.

2. Sanitary Sewer Railroad Crossing Study and Improvements (LBS-274)

CCTV of the railroad crossings were completed on May 6, 2021. A memo summarizing the results was issued on July 16, 2021. There were no major issues requiring replacement found. The contract documents for lining of the crossings are being prepared.

3. Hoey Pump Station Force Main Replacement (LBS-275)

Construction is ongoing. Colliers Engineering & Design and Earle are creating a plan to eliminate air pockets within the new pipe. Final paving is on hold until air issues are resolved.

4. Sludge Holding System Modifications & Final Settling Tank Improvements (LBS-281)

Thomas Controls is working on submittals and shop drawing reviews are proceeding. Anticipated construction start will be January 2022.

5. I/I Study and Improvements (LBS-284)

The recommended collection system improvements were reviewed with the Engineering Committee.



6. Air Permit Renewal (LBS-311P)

Colliers Engineering & Design is coordinating renewal of air permits and compliance review with our subconsultant, Trinity. Trinity has completed the generator general permits. A meeting was held on April 29, 2021 to review the existing permit.

7. Active Escrow Projects

LBS-178 - Chelsea Avenue Development

As-Builts were uploaded to VueWorks. This project is closed.

LBS-233 - Pier Village Phase 3 (in construction)

Contractor to replace one manhole frame and cover. Revised as-builts were submitted on November 10, 2021. WQM-005 has been submitted.

LBS-277 - Transit Village (in construction)

One cleanout cover must be replaced. WQM-005 has been submitted. As-builts to be provided.

LBS-278 - The Reef (in construction)

Sewer main in Ocean Avenue was installed. Road settlement was resolved August 8, 2020.

LBS-282 - The Brighton (in construction)

Final testing and inspection are complete. As-builts must be revised.

LBS-290 - Takanassee (in construction)

Mr. Roguski reported that the Authority has treated an average daily flow of 3.79 MGD, the effluent quality being of a good degree with an average suspended solid discharge of 9.7 ppm and an average B.O.D. discharge of 13.7 ppm. The Authority has met all limits of our discharge permit.

Mr. Roguski stated that as previously reported, the Authority's Coronavirus (COVID-19) Plan and Increased Staffing Plan have been implemented and are currently on-going. Plan adjustments/changes may be needed to address new situations as they arise.

Mr. Fallon stated that he met with Mr. Roguski and Ms. Uyeyama regarding the 2022 Budget. He reported that the budget for 2022 is very similar to the budget for 2021 and there is no increase in the rate required to fund this budget. The Authority didn't use any surplus to supplement this budget. He stated that on the appropriation side there are increases between zero and four percent among the line items. The interest on the debt service decreased six point five percent and the reserves that are budgeted for capital improvements decreased forty eight percent.

Mr. Larco questioned as to why the revenues are the same while many new buildings are being constructed. Mr. Roguski stated that revenues will likely be greater than anticipated however a conservative number is utilized in the budget. Any revenues realized over the anticipated revenue will go into the Authority's net position.

Mrs. Brasefield stated that the Hoey Avenue Pump Station Force Main is experiencing operational issues which are being worked out with the contractor.

Ms. Brasfield reported that shop drawing review is currently on-going for the Sludge Holding and Final Tank System Improvements Project. The construction start date is anticipated to be January 2022.

Mrs. Brasefield reported a meeting with the Engineering Committee will be held regarding the final list of recommendations for the I/I Improvements Project.

Ms. Brasefield reported that the treatment plant air permit is not due at this time but will be renewed when it is due next year.

XV. Miscellaneous Suggestions for the Good of the Authority

Mr. Roguski stated that, at last month's meeting, there was a discussion regarding solar panels potentially being installed on the site behind the Authority on Seaview Avenue. Mr. Lepore gave Mr. Roguski the contact of Mr. George Nicholas from NJ Natural Gas. Mr. Nicholas and Mr. Roguski discussed the possibility of solar panels being installed. Mr. Roguski said that Mr. Nicholas mentioned that solar panels would be a feasible use on the site and that it would be a proposal that they would consider. Mr. Roguski reported that Mr. Nicholas did mention that it would be a minimum of two years before they can potentially sign any agreement or have anything installed on the site, as they are still working to complete their remediation. Mr. Roguski said that Mr. Nicholas mentioned that he understands the need for planning and that NJ Natural Gas would be willing to discuss with the Authority the feasibility for using the site for solar panels. Mr. Roguski wanted to be clear that Mr. Nicholas stated several times that doing such a feasibility study would be financially risky for the Authority, since NJ Natural Gas would have to reserve the right to pull the plug at any time during the feasibility study and any time prior to a formal agreement. The Authority would have to accept such risk, since NJ Natural Gas cannot make any commitments or guarantees at this time. If the Authority is willing to take this kind of risk of NJ Natural Gas pulling the plug at any time, then NJ Natural Gas would be willing to work with the Authority on the feasibility of using the site for solar panels.

Mr. Roguski stated that Colliers Engineering offers services for feasibility studies as required here. Ms. Brasefield affirmed that this kind of service is available, and the price is around \$10,000.00. The Board asked Ms. Brasefield her opinion regarding feasibility, and she stated that physically it is feasible to use solar panels for a good portion of the electric needs that the Authority uses. However, she added that financial viability is questionable and would be part

of the feasibility evaluation. The Board asked Ms. Brasefield to provide a proposal to be presented at the next monthly meeting.

The Board thanked Mr. Lepore for this idea and all his information.

Mr. Lepore stated that the Planning Board declared the field next to Seashore on Broadway a redevelopment zone as of last night, and they are now waiting for plans to come through.

Mr. Lepore thanked Mr. Roguski for contacting NJ Natural Gas and establishing the proper connections. He further thanked Ms. Brasefield for her suggestions for the engineering study and costs. He stated that there have been many other agencies in the city, one being the library that spent thousand of dollars in engineering studies to apply for a grant and get a significate return. He believes the Authority is going in the right direction and should spend the money required for the study. Mr. Lepore added that his main concern is that this should be a project for the Sewerage Authority only and no other City agencies, and he would like that this matter be proposed at the next meeting under executive session.

Mr. Lepore had no further comments.

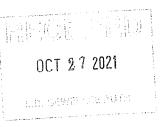

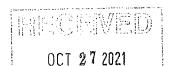

PROPOSAL FOR POSITION OF GENERAL COUNSEL TO THE LONG BRANCH SEWERAGE AUTHORITY

I have been an attorney for sewerage authorities since 1993 and have been reappointed consistently by the various authorities since that time. I have been at the Long Branch Sewerage Authority since 1996, the South Monmouth Regional Sewerage Authority since 1993, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority since 2002 and the Township of Ocean Sewerage Authority since 2011.

During my representation of the above named authorities over the years, I have handled all legal aspects pertinent thereto. I have attended rate hearings, drafted resolutions, and handled all litigation arising from employee disputes and other internal matters. In addition, I have handled the review of contracts as well as the litigation arising out of collection on bid bonds, rejection of bids, selection of bidders and have been in court on numerous occasions in regard to same. During this time, in all of my court matters, I have been successful and the actions of the authorities in which I was representing were affirmed in court. I have worked closely with the Executive Directors and other professionals to handle any issues, problems or questions that may arise through the normal operation of the authorities. I have attended all meetings and workshops as required and have been called in on numerous occasions for special meetings concerning the engineering committee, personnel committees, etc., of the authorities.

I have handled all aspects of the legal matters raised or generated by the operation of the Long Branch Sewerage Authority, the South Monmouth Regional Sewerage Authority, the Eatontown Sewerage Authority, the Township of Ocean Sewerage Authority as well as the Highlands Housing Authority and the West Long Branch Housing Authority; including but not limited to:

- (a) I have handled litigation for all of the above sewerage authorities. These matters include bid challenges on a \$12,000,000.00 public contract and several other contested bids. The issues raised by the litigation were the right to reject all bids and the ability of a bidder to correct his bid by reason of mistake. I succeeded in obtaining summary judgment, dismissing the claim against the Authority involved and re-bidding the contract; which resulted in a substantial savings from the original bids received.
- (b) I have handled litigation on a major \$10,000,000.00 contract by a contractor who brought suit against the Authority claiming \$2,500,000.00 of damages from rejection of change orders and extras. This litigation resulted in the joining of the engineer as a party and all of the suppliers and materialmen in the areas where there were claims for extra monies and/or defects.

After two years of litigation and mediation, the matter settled, with my client getting a substantial benefit.

- (c) I have handled actions on bid bonds, seeking the amount of the bid bond where the lowest bidder refused to go forward and enter into a contract and obtaining the amount of the bond.
- (d) I have handled numerous cases filed by employees bringing actions on contract against an Authority and was generally successful in all of them.

The following is a report on the status of projects for which Colliers Engineering & Design is responsible:

1. WWTP Hot Water System Improvements (LBS-272)

The project was originally bid on February 11, 2020, and there were no bidders. A site meeting was held on July 6, 2021. Colliers Engineering & Design has revised the plans per the meeting and the project will be held for construction until a later date. A PDF of the plans will be provided.

2. Sanitary Sewer Railroad Crossing Study and Improvements (LBS-274)

CCTV of the railroad crossings were completed on May 6, 2021. A memo summarizing the results was issued on July 16, 2021. There were no major issues requiring replacement found. The contract documents for lining of the crossings are being prepared.
