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WHEREAS, David A. Kaplan, Long Branch Sewerage Authority Auditor, has made a written report to the Authority dated May 15, 2019, attached hereto and made a part hereof, regarding the recalculation of the Authority's connection fee Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:14A-8; and

WHEREAS, said report recalculates the connection fee at \$4,446.00 per unit and a per gallon per day connection fee of \$22.90 per gallon for all non-residential connectors, and

WHEREAS, this new connection fee will take effect upon ratification by the Authority after a public hearing scheduled for July 17, 2019, and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:14A-8 requires that notice of the proposed change in the connection fee and the time and place of the public hearing be published in at least two newspapers and mailed to the clerk of each municipality serviced by the Authority at least twenty days before the date the hearing is held and the new connection fee may take effect, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Long Branch Sewerage Authority that:

- 1. The Authority connection fee shall be increased from \$4,388.00 to \$4,446.00 per unit, and a per gallon per day connection fee of \$22.90 per gallon for all non-residential connectors, subject to ratification by the Authority after a public hearing scheduled for July 17, 2019 at 2:45 p.m., and that the Authority's Rules and Regulations are amended accordingly.
 - 2. All other terms of the existing Rules and Regulations remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Pursuant to law, notice of the proposed connection fee and time and place of the connection fee public hearing shall be published in the Link and the Asbury Park Press and sent to clerks of the municipalities serviced by the Authority.
